Article 4. Objectives and Recognition as National Governing Body

Key Proposed Amendments

General language to include and satisfy USOPC requirements as an NGB

USOPC Requirements

A.1 d – International Federation Affiliation

Must be a member of only one international sports federation – ICC

A.9 a & b – Other NGB Responsibilities

 Fulfill all responsibilities as an NGB as set forth by the USOPC and Ted Stevens Olympic Amateur Sports Act

Requires Approval from USAC Board





Article 6. Members

Key Proposed Amendments

- Clarified Organizational Member definitions and strengthened eligibility criteria
- Added new membership categories and expanded other categories, e.g.
 - Professional League/Club New
 - Amateur League/Club Renamed
 - Individual Expanded
- Removed discretion of USAC to accept/reject/withdraw membership without cause

USOPC Requirements

A.1 a & b - Athlete Representation

- Added
 - NGB 10 Year Athletes
 - NGB 10 Year+ Athletes
 Actively Engaged Athletes

A.1 e – Membership Requirements

- Open to individuals and amateur sports organizations in cricket
- Structure includes all applicable groups of individuals or organizations in cricket





Article 6.7 Zones and Conferences

Key Proposed Amendments

- Expanded from 6 to 8 Zones; changed to 2 Conferences
- West Conference
 - Central
 - Central West
 - North West
 - South West
- East Conference
 - Atlantic
 - East
 - North East
 - South



Article 7. Board of Directors

Key Proposed Amendments

- Change Board Composition
 - 4 Athlete Representatives | 3 Independent Directors | 1 League Directors | 1 Club Director | 3 Individual Directors
- Improve General Eligibility Requirements & Qualifications of all Directors to prevent COI
- Align Independent Director (ID) definition with USOPC's ID definition
- Increased number of candidates running for Individual, League, and Club Director positions from 3-5, to 5-7
- Standardized voter eligibility cutoff time of June 30 ahead of an election; candidate must be a registered member in good standing for 2 out of the preceding 3 years, of which 12 of those months must be immediately preceding the June 30 cutoff date for elections.

USOPC Requirements

A.1 a - Athlete Representation

• 33.3% athlete representation on the board of directors

A.1 c - Independent & Affiliate Representation

- Add Affiliate Board Position if such organization exists
- Tighten Independent Director eligibility criteria

A.3 a - Board Governance

- Tighten Conflict of Interest requirements
- Administer elections fairly, consistently and appropriately





Article 7. Board of Directors (con't)

Key Proposed Amendments

- Require Officers of USA Cricket to resign from office if elections are not held
- Ensure board members cannot serve beyond 6 consecutive years total for any reason
- Expand conditions for removal of board directors if in breach of Code of Ethics
- Stipulate that board directors must complete SafeSport training as part of onboarding

USOPC Requirements

A.3 a - Board Governance

- Administer elections fairly, consistently and appropriately
- Have explicit board member terms and term limits
- Have a process for removal of board members

A.3 b – Board Development

USOPC training for board members





Article 8. Officers

Key Proposed Amendments

- Add 'Executive Secretary' Officer role. Scope:
 - Record minutes
 - Provide notices to members and manage logistics of meetings
 - Be the custodian of corporate records

USOPC Requirements

A.3 a – Board Governance

Assists in meeting minimum standards for governance practices

A.3 c – Board Meeting Minutes

Must post Board Meeting Minutes for the past three years on website

A.7 a-d – NGB Annual Reports

 Must submit annual reports to the USOPC with information describing how the organization maintains compliance





Article 9. Committees

Key Proposed Amendments

- Terms reduced to 2 years
- Restructured the Cricket Committee to focus on Men's Cricket
- Added new standing committees to align with strategic focus areas
 - Development Committee
 - Women's Cricket Committee
 - Officials and Umpires Committee
- Updated composition of Audit Committee
- Revised composition of NGC to remove USOPC's appointee and clarify COI criteria

USOPC Requirements

A.1 b - Athlete Representation

- 33.3% NGB 10 Year & 10 Year+ Athletes on Designated Committees
- 33.3% NGB Actively Engaged Athletes on Other Committees

A.2 a - Athlete Advisory Council

- 100% athlete representatives; 6-12 members
- At least 80% are NGB 10 Year Athletes
- Remainder are NGB 10 Year or 10 Year+ Athletes

A.3 a - Board Governance

Election, selection and removal procedures for committee members





Article 11. Athletes' Advisory Council

Key Proposed Amendments

- Added an Athletes' Advisory Council
- 6 members

USOPC Requirements

A.2 a - Athlete Advisory Council

- 100% athlete representatives; 6-12 members
- Best Practice: Equal representation of gender
- At least 80% are NGB 10 Year Athletes
- Remainder are NGB 10 Year or 10 Year+ Athletes

Requires Approval from USAC Board





Article 17. Records of USA Cricket

Key Proposed Amendments

- Must post the last three (3) years of Board Meeting Minutes to website
- Publish a list of members on an annual basis

USOPC Requirements

A.3 c – Board Meeting Minutes

Must post Board Meeting Minutes for the past three years on website

Requires Approval from USAC Board
