## Article 6. Members

## **Key Proposed Amendments**

- Moved definitions of all Member classes to its own section
- Added USOPC 10YR, 10YR+, & Actively Engaged Athletes clarification to Individual definition
- Minimum number of clubs to constitute a League increased from 4 to 8 and can include female clubs
- Rename Other Organization to Associate Organization and added forprofit organizations to this member class
- Strengthened eligibility criteria to determine legitimate leagues
- Clarified that Clubs must have at least twelve (12) or more registered Individual Members who are at least eighteen (18) years old
- Removed discretion of USAC to accept/reject/withdraw membership
- Added language that requires Individual members to comply with all anti-doping rules of ICC, USOPC, WADA, USADA

- Open to individuals and amateur sports organizations in cricket
- Structure includes all applicable groups of individuals or organizations in cricket

#### A.9 a & b – Other NGB Responsibilities

 Fulfill all responsibilities as an NGB as set forth by the USOPC and Ted Stevens Olympic Amateur Sports Act





## Article 6.7 & 6.9

## **Key Proposed Amendments**

- Expanded from 6 to 8 Zones; changed to 2 Conferences
- West Conference
  - Central
  - Central West
  - North West
  - South West
- East Conference
  - Atlantic
  - East
  - North East
  - South
- Added a Force Majeur clause



## Article 7. Board of Directors

## **Key Proposed Amendments**

- Improved eligibility requirements of all Directors to prevent COI
- Changed Board Composition
  - 4 Athlete Representatives | 3 Independent Directors | 1 League Directors | 1 Club Director | 3 Individual Directors
- Added restriction to support geographic representation among Independent, Individual and Player Directors
- Added Team USA Athlete's Commission representation requirement
- Clarified definition of an International Player
- Added possibility for simplified re-nomination process for Independent Directors running for a 2<sup>nd</sup> term
- Reassigned responsibility from the NGC to the Ethics, Grievance and Disciplinary Committee to evaluate board candidates' conflicts and ethics concerns

## **USOPC Requirements**

#### A.1 a - Athlete Representation

• 33.3% athlete representation on the board of directors

#### A.1 c - Independent & Affiliate Representation

Tighten Independent Director eligibility criteria

#### A.3 a - Board Governance

- Tighten Conflict of Interest requirements
- Administer elections fairly, consistently and appropriately





## Article 7. Board of Directors (con't)

## **Key Proposed Amendments**

- Require Individual, Club and League Director candidates to submit two
   (2) letters of recommendations from USA Cricket members
- Increased number of candidates running for Individual, League, and Club Director positions
- Standardized voter eligibility cutoff time of June 30 ahead of an election;
- Individual, Club and League Director Candidate must be a registered member in good standing for 2 out of the preceding 3 years, of which 12 of those months must be immediately preceding the June 30 cutoff date for elections.
- Added Affiliate Organization Director position as required by USOPC
- Mandate Directors to receive US Center for SafeSport training at onboarding

## **USOPC Requirements**

#### A.1 c – Independent and Affiliate Representation

Add Affiliate Organization Board Position if such organization exists

#### A.3 a – Board Governance

- Administer elections fairly, consistently and appropriately
- Have explicit board member terms and term limits
- Have a process for removal of board members

#### A.3 b – Board Development

USOPC training for board members





## Article 7. Board of Directors (con't)

## **Key Proposed Amendments**

- Require Officers of USA Cricket to resign from office if elections are not held
- Added the tenure of existing board members to address staggering lost with previous Board Director elections delayed prior to 2023
- Aligned Player Director terms with mandated Team USA Athlete's Commission terms to two, four-year (4-year) terms
- Ensure board members cannot serve beyond 6 (or 8 years for Player Directors) consecutive years total for any reason
- Mandated Directors who served their max consecutive years to take 2year cooling off period before being eligible to run for elections
- Expanded conditions for removal of Directors in breach of Code of Ethics
- Specified that Directors shall not receive compensation for their services

#### A.3 a - Board Governance

- Administer elections fairly, consistently and appropriately
- Have explicit board member terms and term limits
- Have a process for removal of board members





## Article 8. Officers

## **Key Proposed Amendments**

- Added 'Executive Secretary' Officer role. Scope:
  - Record minutes
  - Provide notices to members and manage logistics of meetings
  - Be the custodian of corporate records

## **USOPC Requirements**

#### A.3 a – Board Governance

Assists in meeting minimum standards for governance practices

#### A.3 c – Board Meeting Minutes

Must post Board Meeting Minutes for the past three years on website

#### A.7 a-d – NGB Annual Reports

 Must submit annual reports to the USOPC with information describing how the organization maintains compliance





## Article 9. Committees

## **Key Proposed Amendments**

- Terms reduced to 2 years, except Leagues Committee which will be 1 yr
- Restructured the Cricket Committee to focus on U19s to seniors
- Added 2 Standing Committees to align with strategic focus areas
  - Development Committee
  - Women's Cricket Committee
- Require each committee to have 33.3% Athlete Representatives appointed by the USAC Athlete's Advisory Council (AAC)
- Added the Board can remove any committee member, except Athlete Representatives who can only be removed by the USAC (AAC)
- Removed USOPC's appointee to the NGC (at USOPC's request) and tightened COI criteria
- Reduced Ethics Committee to 5 members

## **USOPC Requirements**

#### A.1 b - Athlete Representation

- 33.3% USOPC 10 Year & 10 Year+ Athletes on Designated Committees
- 33.3% NGB Actively Engaged Athletes on Other Committees

#### A.2 a - Athlete Advisory Council

- 100% athlete representatives; 6-12 members
- At least 80% are NGB 10 Year Athletes
- Remainder are NGB 10 Year or 10 Year+ Athletes

#### A.3 a - Board Governance

## Article 9. Committees

## **Key Proposed Amendments**

- Reduced Leagues Committee composition from 15 to 12 members
- Reduced composition of Audit Committee from 8 to 5 members and added qualifications

#### A.1 b - Athlete Representation

- 33.3% USOPC 10 Year & 10 Year+ Athletes on Designated Committees
- 33.3% NGB Actively Engaged Athletes on Other Committees

## Article 20. Amendment of Constitution

## **Key Proposed Amendments**

• Updated Article numbers in Article 20.2 to ensure the article continues to reference the correct Article. This is based on new articles added to the constitution which changed Article 18. Amendment of Constitution to Article 20. Amendment of Constitution

## Article 4. Objectives and Recognition as National Governing Body

## **Key Approved Amendments**

- General language to include and satisfy USOPC requirements as an NGB
- · For Noting:
  - Timeline to fulfill USOPC constitutional requirements would be as soon as reasonably practicable.
  - USOPC provided a high-level timeline for USAC to achieve certified NGB status with the USOPC by 2026.
  - USAC has begun working with the USOPC to meet all governance and operational requirements. This is a 2-year journey.

## **USOPC Requirements**

#### A.1 d – International Federation Affiliation

Must be a member of only one international sports federation – ICC

#### A.9 a & b – Other NGB Responsibilities

 Fulfill all responsibilities as an NGB as set forth by the USOPC and Ted Stevens Olympic Amateur Sports Act





## Article 11. Athletes' Advisory Council

## **Key Approved Amendments**

- Added an Athletes' Advisory Council per USOPC requirements
- Council comprises 6 members with gender balance

## **USOPC Requirements**

#### A.2 a - Athlete Advisory Council

- 100% athlete representatives; 6-12 members
- Best Practice: Equal representation of gender
- At least 80% are NGB 10 Year Athletes
- Remainder are NGB 10 Year or 10 Year+ Athletes





## Article 12. Team USA Athletes' Commission

## **Key Approved Amendments**


- Added Team USA Athletes' Commission Article per USOPC requirements
- Defined qualifications, eligibility, election/selection procedures, removal procedures, tenure and term limits

## Article 17. Records of USA Cricket

## **Key Approved Amendments**

- Must post the last three (3) years of Board Meeting Minutes to website
- Publish a list of members on an annual basis

## **USOPC Requirements**

#### A.3 c – Board Meeting Minutes

Must post Board Meeting Minutes for the past three years on website
